

# Is Russia Returning to Communism?

Soviet Communism was an era of indoctrination, propaganda, prisons and slave camps that affected millions of people for 75 years. Few understood the depths of its evil. Fear silenced many.

My father refused to be silent. In his autobiography, *Tortured for His Faith* (TFHF), he exposed the evils of Communism.

*Tortured for His Faith* has been published in 26 languages but, ironically, not in Russian!

## Why publish this story in Russian?

I am concerned about the new generation of Russian youth. They are being swept into Putin cultism, a movement similar to Stalin's Pioneer camps which I am more than familiar with from my own school years in Communist Bulgaria. Today's Russian youth are ignorant to the atrocities of Communism. This is kept out of their history books.

Putin's NASHI or "Our" youth camps are the largest of several pro-Kremlin youth groups. Hundreds of thousands of young people 15-23 years of age, who were born after the fall of the Iron Curtain, have been recruited since NASHI's initiation in 2004.

In the youth camps, former KGB agent Vladimir Putin's portrait hangs paternally in prominent places. Lectures are given on:

- The evils of American democracy and attempted world domination
- How Russia will reemerge as a global power
- The need for procreation for the Motherland
- Classes on the greatness of Putin's political theory

All lectures are compulsory and monitored. Electronic chips in name tags tell organizers if you don't attend and you are immediately expelled from camp.



The Putin camps are popular. Its members are unwittingly partaking in the creation of a new Soviet-styled nation built on indoctrination of vulnerable youth.

## **Arkady Polishchuk, translator of *TFHF* into Russian**

A former member of the Soviet Communist Party and successful journalist in Moscow, Arkady Polishchuk became disenchanted

with Communism after the Soviet invasion of Czechoslovakia in 1968. He was thrown out of the "elite" group and joined the Jewish dissident movement and became a human rights activist. In the early '80s he was a part of Door of Hope's *Russian Open Bible-Study Bible* editorial team.

During the Cold War years, while Door of Hope International actively gathered evidence of Russian atrocities and "smuggled" documents for publication in the West, Arkady traveled the Soviet Union secretly collecting information on the persecuted Christians that DOHI published.
