

Evin Prison, Tehran, is well known for its mass executions (30,000 political prisoners in 1988), human rights violations and extensive use of solitary confinement designed to break the prisoner to confess and divulge information.

Dear friend,

I met Pastor Farshid Fahti in Anatolia, Turkey. We had prayed for him for years. When he was arrested in 2010, he spent 361 days in solitary confinement in Evin Prison, Iran, before being transferred to the

political ward, then to the much harsher Rasht prison. After his release I was thrilled to learn he was now in Turkey and wanted to meet him. I recognized him immediately and introduced myself.

"I know of a Haralan Popov, but not a Paul," he told me. I was intrigued. How did he know my father?

"I read your father's book while in prison in Iran!" he exclaimed. It was the first print of Tortured For His Faith translated into the Farsi language. I was intrigued. How did he get it?

The miraculous travel of Dad's book.

First, someone smuggled it from Turkey into Iran. Then, a friend brought it to Farshid in prison. Somehow the book bypassed mandatory government inspections and passed the icid awards. Being a "googge and" prisoner Boston Farshig

"My suffering," said Farshid, "suddenly seemed small. In comparison to what your father went through, especially the *Death Diet*, I knew if he could survive all those years, surely I could too! I now felt hope. It also renewed the faith of other Christians imprisoned with me and encouraged them to stay strong in the Lord."

"Many Muslims read the book too! In the political ward are intelligent, well-educated men. One Muslim I remember in particular, *Dr. Namazi, a professor, would ask me for books. I gave him Tortured for His Faith. The next morning he came to me with red eyes."

"Farshid, I couldn't sleep all night. I planned only to read a little before sleep but couldn't stop until I finished reading it all," he said. "Even he, a Muslim man, was greatly impacted by the book!" recalled Farshid.

When Farshid was released he left Tortured for His Faith on the prison library shelf that God may continue using it in the lives of other prisoners.

Fatemeh (Mary) Mohammadi spoke out for Christians imprisoned simply for converting from Islam. Mary, as she prefers to be called, is a well-known social media blogger who shared their tragic stories with her many followers.

For this, Mary was severely beaten and thrown into Qarchak Prison in Varamin, Iran, a prison that has been sanctioned by the US for "gross human rights violations."

My heart breaks for Mary. This young girl, who so bravely spoke up for other Christians, is now herself in jail.

Fatemeh (Mary) Mohammadi, a Muslim convert arrested Jan 12, 2020, is awaiting her court trial.

As I write this, Mary was released on bail pending her court trial. Please pray for her as the coronavirus that has hit Iran hard makes it very dangerous for her.


